They will remain in these clothes all day. On a Thursday we will be starting a Golden Mile and PE session (more details to follow) so a PE kit will need to be worn all day. A busy week ahead!

Maths

Next week we will be looking at place value in numbers. We will be comparing and ordering numbers and we will be using the correct mathematical language when talking about numbers and what each digit represents. We will be using a number line to order numbers.

Next week we will consolidate multiplication and division and use this knowledge to solve word problems. We will use practical resources and draw pictures to embed our understanding of key concepts. We will begin daily mental maths starters, looking at number bonds to 10, 20 and for some, up to 100.

Literacy

Next week we will continue to learn about minibeasts. We will be reading and writing about minibeasts and we will be finding out about different creatures. We will be writing riddles about minibeasts using different clues to help solve the riddle! We will continue to do daily phonics.

Next week we will be continuing to learn about minibeasts. We will use our knowledge from this week to write riddles and also write a Japanese form of poetry called Haikus. We will take part in oral poetry reading and group work to explore a range of good vocabulary that will feed into our poetry writing.
