Maths

Next week we will continue our addition and subtraction unit of work. We will again focus on addition, number bonds to ten, comparing number bonds, adding together and adding more.

Next week we will be consolidating our learning on multiplication. We will move onto division, looking at different strategies we can use in order to solve division number sentences and division problems.

Literacy

Next week, we will continue to find out about 'Percy the Park Keeper' and his friends. We will be using adjectives to describe the characters and settings that we find in the Percy the Park Keeper story 'One Snowy Night'.

Next week we will be continuing to write our stories based on the "Great Outdoors". We will be looking at how sentence starters and adjectives can improve our writing and we will be editing our learning to make it even better!

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Foundation Subjects
