

Year R lockdown learning ideas to do at home...

Literacy

- name practice - looking at correct formation of letters
- any sounds we have covered so far (the weekly video of sounds to be learnt will continue to come)
- blending and segmenting simple CVC words using the sounds we have learnt (example: cat/ dog/ hen/ pin/ tip) talk through each sound before blending them together
- daily reading - looking at books/ talking through stories etc
- any mark making / writing children want to do - draw pictures and encourage child to "write" about it -can they tell you what the picture is about? Can they write sounds or make marks for writing? can they read their writing back to you?

Numeracy

- counting 0 - 20 in order, can children count forwards and backwards?
- recognising individual numbers in context and out of context (example: in a number line and as an individual number)
- finding "x" objects to correspond to a given number -can they count each object as they find it? can they re count it to check?
- look at simple coins the value of each coin
