Maths	Next week, we will continue our addition and subtraction unit of work. We will continue to focus on subtraction. Taking away, counting back using a number line and fact families.	Next week in Maths, the children will move onto addition of a one digit number to a two digit number and use the part-whole model. The children will take part in problem solving activities related to this and will use the part-whole model to understand related addition and subtraction facts.
Literacy	Next week, we will be thinking about giving... The soldiers giving their lives, as we find out about and write about Remembrance Day. Giving our money to charity including 'Children in Need' and Itakiya. Also giving our time, doing acts of kindness and things that we can do to take care of each other.	Next week in English we will be completing Remembrance Day comprehensions, looking at the poem 'Flanders Field' and the language used and then writing our own Remembrance Day poems. For their grammar lesson, the children will use the poem to identify and highlight the nouns, verbs and adjectives.

## Foundation Subjects

Next week in...
