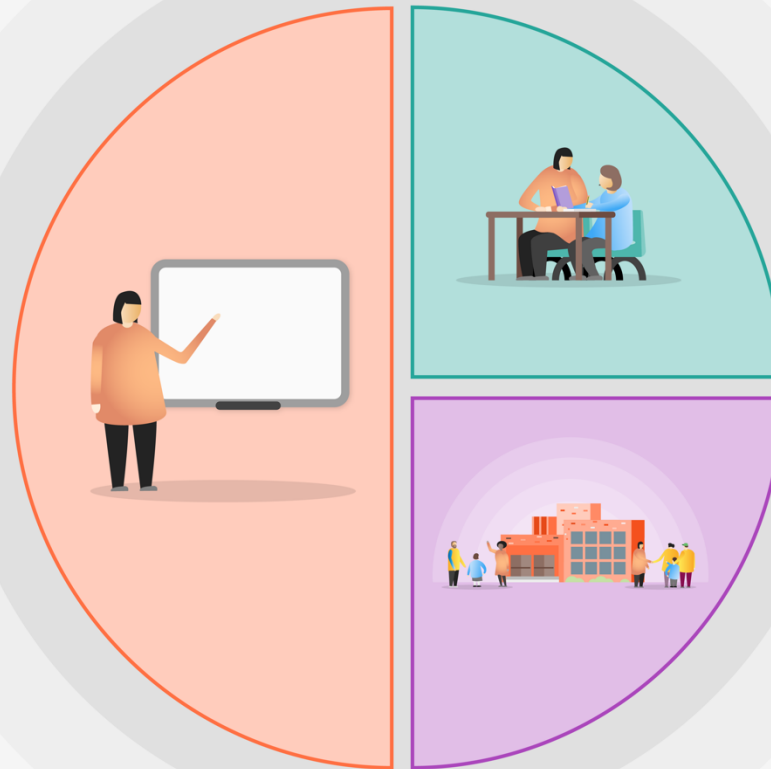


St Michael's Infant School

1 Teaching

- Whole school training on **Recovery Curriculum** levers (Barry Carpenter)
- Whole school twilight on **Emotional Coaching** – E.P Rebecca Walker
- **Story Project** training and dissemination to all staff an inclusion into the RSE/PSHE curriculum
- Staff **well-being** interviews
- Additional time spent on **curriculum and deep dive reviews** for subject leaders to establish adaptations for the curriculum on return in September 2020
- Additional staff meetings to discuss adaptations to **assessment approaches** (January 2021) in response to lockdown
- Review of **on-line platforms** used to support remote learning
- Extra leadership support for early career leader in 1st year of Head of School role



2 Targeted academic support

- **Phonics** assessment (teachers) and targeted interventions KS1 (TAs)
- **Phonics, physical phonics, maths, reading** and **writing** interventions Y1/Y2
- ELSA support for identified children (above standard offer)
- Nurture group (brunch) across the school
- Lunchtime nurture club (butterfly club)
- P.E for well-being (targeted groups/individuals)
- Mentoring (1:1) phonics and reading

3 Wider strategies

- Additional telephone and zoom parent consultations to support families
- Use of Leuven scale to track well-being across the whole school.
- Adapted curriculum to include focus on outdoor learning, recovery curriculum levers, collaborative play opportunities, values and Bee rules re-focus
- Offer 3 classes of 15 max. during January 2021 lockdown
