Ladybird Class Weekly Update

I am not sure how we are in December already... but another week of great learning has flown by!

Next week we are beginning to think about the big C word – Christmas!

As always, we will continue to look at sounds, blending and segmenting green words. We are also continuing to write simple CVC words, listening to each of the sounds. We are now encouraging the children to sound the words in their head (you may hear them say FRED in your head!).

In Literacy, we will be assessing phonics as we will be starting set 2 sounds after Christmas. We will also be looking at the Christmas story and writing a small part of it. We will continue to think about adjectives in order to make our writing more exciting.

In Numeracy, we will be assessing numbers, more and less and we will be continuing to look at addition and addition number sentences. We will be introducing different ways to solve problems.

We are all getting tired (I know I am!), but we are nearly there, so please continue to keep up with the reading, homework and bringing in water bottles. Remember it is Christmas lunch next week.
