Ladybird Class Weekly Update

Yet again, another great week. We had a fun world Book Day!

We are revisiting the set 2 sounds again. We will focus on ow, oo (look at a book) and oo (poo at the zoo) next week. Please revisit the videos from last term.

Our red words are: call, there, her, me, to. We will look at these for the next 2 weeks. Please continue to revisit all of the past RED words.

We have our ducklings arriving on Monday (how exciting!) so we will be focussing on them a lot for the next 2 weeks.

We will have a big PSED focus on how to look after ducklings, caring for them etc. In Literacy, for the next 2 weeks we will be focussing on the life cycle of a duck and looking at whole class writing in order to edit and improve our work.

In Numeracy, we are continuing to look at the whole, part, part model and we will be exploring the composition of numbers to 5 then 10.

In Science we are identifying and naming UK animals.

In History we will be recalling the events of the Great Fire of London and putting the events in the correct order.

We had a lovely time celebrating World Book Day. Thank you for supporting your children to become involved in the day!

Here is what we will be doing next week:

In English, we will be finishing our stories from last week alongside editing parts to make improvements. The children will also be catching up on some of their guided reading tasks.

In Maths, we will be finishing our unit on fractions. We will be exploring and solving a mixture of fractions such as finding a half, quarter, two quarters, a third and two thirds of different amounts. We will link this to our division learning. The children will also be solving fraction problems.

In Science, we will be exploring a variety of habitats, identifying creatures which may live there and exploring how they are suited to that habitat.

In History, we will be reviewing what we knew about the Great Fire of London at the start of the term and what we know now. We will also be creating books about the Great Fire of London (this is something the children have asked to do).

In RE, we will be exploring the meaning behind the parable of *The Lost Coin*.

Whole Class Guided Reading: We will be exploring the poem *The Great Fire of London* by Paul Perro.
