We are continuing to visit the set 2 sounds and apply them to our writing. We are encouraging independent writing this term.

We will continue to look at the RED words: want, go, old, some, he.

Next week we are continuing to look at the story "Dear Zoo". We will be finishing off our writing about our own zoo animals and we will be writing about zoos in general, adding adjectives to improve our work.

In Numeracy, we will be focussing on the composition of numbers to 5, looking at doubles and subtraction.

Dragonfly Class Weekly Update

Friday already! We have had a busy week and have especially enjoyed observing our cress and beans growing.

In English the children will be writing descriptive poems next week. For homework, we have sent home a picture that the children will use as inspiration for their poetry plus an activity for them to do at home that will support their writing. The children will be using adjectives, adverbs and their senses to write the poems.

In Maths the children will continue their unit on statistics, focusing on block diagrams. The children will solve problems involving statistics. We will continue to focus on empty box calculations.

In Geography we will be using compass points to navigate our way around a farm. We will also be looking at map symbols and keys.

In RE we will be exploring why Muslims follow examples of Mohammad and what a prophet is.

In DT we will be designing our own food product using fruit and/or veg. We will be writing a recipe including the ingredients and method.
