In Numeracy, we will be focussing on subtraction, we have spent more time on doubles this week than we thought we would! We have been learning a doubles song – please do look at it

At the end of the week, we will be applying this knowledge to solve time word problems. We will also be exploring fact families (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

In Science we will be exploring seed dispersal and finding out the different ways different seeds are dispersed.

In Geography we will look at what happens on farms during the different seasons.

In RE we will be pausing to draw together all we have learnt about Islam so far.
