### Ladybird Class Weekly Update

We are looking at our last minibeast – the worm! We will be looking at the story “Super Worm” and we will be writing as a whole class. We will be focussing on letter formation, finger spaces and full stops. We will be trying to edit and improve our writing if we can!

In Numeracy, we will be continuing to look at money and we will go shopping! The children have enjoyed our shop and have enjoyed “buying things”! We will continue to look at the language of money.
