Ladybird Class Weekly Update

What another super week we have had Ladybird class. We are so incredibly proud of how you are all coming in so happily.

Next week we will continue with our set 1 phonics sounds and videos will be sent home accordingly. We are looking at 'My Family' and will be drawing our families. In guided reading we will read 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and will be doing lots of activities linked to the book throughout the week.

The children have had their first week of changing for PE and Forest School - please do ensure that items are labelled with your child's name.

Do continue to enjoy sharing the wordless books together at home with your child. Tonight your child should have also brought home a library book to enjoy. We will visit the library each Friday so please pop in their library book in their book bags on this day each week so they can choose a new book.

Butterfly Class Weekly Update

The children have had a brilliant week this week, they have enjoyed the Three Little Pigs activities and have all spent time exploring the classroom.

Next week we will be comparing and ordering numbers and making our own number lines. In Literacy we will be continuing our work with the Read, Write, Inc books.

We will be reading the story of Little Red Riding Hood and will have lots of fun classroom activities based on this.

In Art we will be creating spiral observational drawings of shells, using a range of different materials.

In Geography we will be labelling the countries on a map and the capital cities.

We will be changing the children's library books on Mondays – don't forget to bring yours in on Monday.

Dragonfly Class Weekly Update

This term is flying by and we are getting excited about our Harvest celebrations!

Next week.....

In English we will be writing riddles based on the characters in *The Paper Bag Princess*. We will also be having a SPAG focus (spelling, punctuation and grammar).

In Maths we will be continuing to practise writing numbers in words, we will be learning to flexibly partition two digit numbers (so in different ways other than combinations of tens and ones - e.g. 28 can be made up of 15 and 13 or 10 and 18), we will be writing numbers in their expanded form (i.e. $48 = 28 + 20$) and also beginning to identify 10's on a number line where some numbers are missing.

In Science we will be exploring why specific materials are used to make objects and how their properties make them suitable.

In Geography we will be learning how to use a simple map and looking at keys on maps.

In RE: Due to the Queen's funeral, we did not cover last week's RE lesson so we will do that next week. We continue to ask the question 'Why do Christians go to Church?' and think about special events. This week is weddings.

In Art we will be learning to use different media for creating continuous drawings and we will be sketching based on the sense of 'feel'. This means that the children will be holding something unidentified behind their backs and then use their dominant hand to sketch what it is.

In Whole Class Guided Reading our book will be *The Kiss that Missed*.
