## Butterfly Class Weekly Update

We have all been interested to learn about Remembrance Day this week, we made poppies and wrote different facts.

Next week in Maths we are beginning to learn about 3d shapes, we will be exploring them through the week.

In Literacy we are continuing to focus on our sentence writing.

We have been enjoying learning about printing and thinking about different ways to create prints in our environment. We will be continuing to learn about different ways to make prints.

We will be learning about castles and thinking about their structures and the buildings.

## Dragonfly Class Weekly Update

We have started practising our Christmas Play and are beginning to feel festive!

### **Next week:**

**In English** we will be writing postcards using our key text, *Goldilocks and Just One Bear*, as our starting point.

**In Maths**, we will be consolidating number bonds to 100 (in tens), adding and subtracting a one-digit number from a two-digit number, adding 3 one-digit numbers together and also adding to the next 10. In addition to this, we will be solving problems related to these areas.

**In Science** we will be looking at different habitats and which animals are suited to them.

**In Topic** we will be exploring the features of the castles built by the Normans and why these castles were so important to the Normans.

**In Art** we will be making Poppy pictures, using watercolour.

**In RE**, we will continue to focus on our RE unit for this half term - 'Why is the Bible an important book?' and this week, we will be learning about letters and psalms in the Bible.

**In PSHE** we will be focusing on *Anti-Bullying Week* and on *Children in Need*.
